

USE OF ADDITIONAL DISABLED VETERANS CREDITS

Effective January 1, 2014 New York State law provides additional veterans credit to veterans who:

1. **Used** non-disabled veterans credits to obtain a civil service appointment or promotion with New York State or a local government.
AND
2. **Subsequent** to such appointment are determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to be a qualified **disabled** veteran, as defined in the New York State Civil Service Law.

Such candidates shall be entitled to an additional 10 credits on civil service examinations, minus the number of credits already used for the prior appointment.

If you wish to claim the additional disabled veterans credits you must also submit Form VC-1, Application For Veterans Credits and Form VC-3, Authorization For Disability Record and your separation papers (DD-214). These forms must be received by the Civil Service Department prior to the establishment of the eligible list resulting from an examination.
