NOTICE

HOME HEATING OIL RETAILERS

Suffolk County Code requires that all vehicles delivering liquid petroleum fuel (including #1, #2, #4 and #6 oils) for residential home heating use in Suffolk County must be clearly and conspicuously marked with the identity of the vehicle's owner or operator. The law is intended to assist officials in assuring that each vehicle's meter has been properly tested. The law also assists consumers who might need to contact a business.

The main points of the law are as follows:

WHAT INFORMATION MUST BE DISPLAYED?

- 1) The name of the owner. "Owner" includes a lessee of a vehicle if the lease is for a period greater than 30 days.
- 2) The address of the owner, including the street number, community and zip code.
- 3) The telephone number of the owner, including the area code.
- 4) The identification number of the vehicle, assigned by the owner, if the company owns more than one vehicle.

If the owner's name appears on the vehicle and the owner's street address and telephone number are listed in any current edition of the Suffolk County telephone directory under the owner's name **AS IT IS DISPLAYED ON THE VEHICLE**, then it is not necessary to display the address or telephone number on the vehicle.

WHERE AND HOW MUST THE INFORMATION BE DISPLAYED?

On the driver and passenger doors of the vehicle's cab, in letters at least two inches high and one inch wide.

WHO ENFORCES THIS LAW?
