Opioid Overdose Awareness Program

Presented in partnership with Suffolk County Health Services and The Suffolk County Sheriff's Department

In an effort to reverse this trend in Suffolk County, the Opioid Overdose Prevention Program trains participants how to recognize an opioid overdose, administer intranasal **Narcan** and take appropriate steps until EMS arrives.

Participants (**adults only**) will receive a certificate of completion and an emergency resuscitation kit that includes two doses of Narcan. This free training meets New York State Department of Health requirements.
