The presentation explains why heroin is more prominently used by our youth, compared to the more costly prescription drugs and shows parents and educators what to look for if you suspect your child might be involved in heroin use. This is also a great tool for parents with pre-teen and teenage children to raise your awareness. The presentation also touches on the physical symptoms to look for in a heroin user and concludes with a list of resources for parents if they suspect their child is involved with drug use. They will also be bringing drug paraphernalia so you can see exactly what to look for.
