E. Springer reported that he received a complaint from A. Tyczkowski from Southampton Town Fire Marshal's Office. He found Master Fire Prevention Systems, Inc. doing business without a certificate or registration.

E. Springer reported he received a complaint from A. Cardali from Babylon Town Fire Marshal's Office. He issued a summons to O. Mercado of King's Fire Protection, Inc. for servicing a system without a license.

E. Springer reported he received a complaint from C. Mount from Brookhaven Town Fire Marshal's Office. He found that Long Island Extinguisher, Inc. did not install the LPR nozzles to manufacturer's design and installation manual.
