**Open to Young Hunters  
Ages 12-15**

The Youth Waterfowl Program is a special event to help junior hunters prepare for and participate in the Youth Waterfowl Days. Youth Waterfowl Days are two days each year, set outside the regular duck hunting season in each waterfowl zone, when any junior hunter may hunt ducks and geese.

Junior hunters must be accompanied by a licensed adult hunter. Adults cannot hunt during these two days.

In the Long Island Zone for 2016 - the Youth Waterfowl Days are November 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>.

Students will have the option of hunting at one of the following parks:

Hubbard County Park, Flanders  
Southaven County Park, Yaphank

The Youth Waterfowl Program will take place on:

**November 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>**

All applicants will be required to attend the instructional day at Hubbard County Park in Flanders. Certified Sportsman Education Instructors, as well as Environmental Conservation Officers will be present to guide you through the program and help you learn to become a part of the long tradition of waterfowl hunting on Long Island.

Participants must:

- Be 12 - 15 years of age by November 12<sup>th</sup>
- Have completed a hunter education course by November 5<sup>th</sup>
- Possess a Junior small game hunting license by November 12<sup>th</sup>
- Register with the Harvest Information Program (HIP): information on how to do this will be provided on the instructional day.

Space is limited to 35 students. You will be notified as to whether or not you are accepted.
