All Suffolk County residents who have a valid Green Key Card with handicapped status are entitled to free weekday admission to most County Parks and reduced fees for some activities. Green Key Cards can be purchased at any of the County Golf Courses, Campgrounds, Active Parks or the Parks Administration Office in West Sayville. You will need to show your NY State Access Pass on the Suffolk County Identification Card issued by the Suffolk County Office of Handicapped Services. The fee for the card is \$11.00 and it is valid for 3 years.\*


This brochure will help you locate the Accessible Playgrounds, surf chairs, golf carts, hunting blinds and more to help make your park experience enjoyable.



The Suffolk County Parks Department is committed to improving the accessibility at all our County Parks. Below is a list of accessible Parks. Not all facilities listed at each park are accessible. Please check with park personnel. For further information call each park or the Administration Office at (631) 854-4949.

**1 WEST HILLS COUNTY PARK**  
Huntington (631) 854-4423

**Facilities Include:** Youth Group, Camping Areas, Horseback Riding, Meeting Hall, Picnicking, Nature Trails and Restrooms. \* Accessible Nature Trail at Sweet Hollow Hall.  
**Directions:** I-19 to Exit 48 Round Swamp Road. North on Round Swamp to High Hold Drive. Right on High Hold Drive. Park Entrance is on the right.

**2 GARDINER COUNTY PARK**  
Bay Shore (631) 854-4949  
(631) 854-0935 (Seasonal)

**Facilities Include:** Nature Trails and Restrooms.  
**Directions:** Park Entrance is on the south side of Montauk Highway, about one-half mile east of the Robert Moses Causeway.

**3 BLYDENBURGH COUNTY PARK**  
Smithtown (631) 854-3713

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Youth and Group Areas, Fishing, Picnicking, Boating, Nature Trails and Restrooms.  
**Directions:** Enter park from north side of Veterans Memorial Highway, opposite the H. Lee Dennison Building.

**4 LAKELAND COUNTY PARK**  
Islandia (631) 853-2727 (Seasonal)  
(631) 854-4949

**Facilities Include:** Accessible Playground, a Picnic area with Gazebo, Restrooms, Basketball and Shuffleboard Courts, Self Guided Interpretive Sensory Trails, Tactile Maps for the Visually Impaired and Nature Trails, of which 3500 feet are Boardwalks or a Surfaced Area.  
**Directions:** I-19 to Exit 58. Head south on Old Nichols Road. Make a left on Johnson Avenue, the park is on the right side.

**5 LAKE RONKONKOMA COUNTY PARK**  
Lake Ronkonkoma (631) 854-9699

**Facilities Include:** Picnicking, Handball, Basketball, Ball Fields, Restrooms, and a New State of the Art Accessible Playground.  
**Directions:** I-19 Exit 58 Old Nichols Road. North on Nichols to Smithtown Blvd. East on Smithtown Blvd., bear right at fork to Park Entrance.

**6 SOUTHAVEN COUNTY PARK**  
Brookhaven (631) 854-1414

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Horseback riding, Group Areas, Canoeing, Fishing, Hunting, Picnicking, Boating, Nature Trails, Restrooms, and Playgrounds. Accessible Duck Blind available for Duck Hunting. Call park for information and availability.  
**Directions:** Park Entrance is via the Sunrise Highway access road on the north side of Sunrise.

**7 SMITH POINT COUNTY PARK**  
Shirley (631) 852-1313

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Fishing, Picnicking, Outer Beach Area, Restrooms, Playground, and Swimming. (surf chair available).  
**Directions:** William Floyd Parkway South to the end, to Park Entrance.

**8 INDIAN ISLAND COUNTY PARK**  
Riverhead (631) 852-3232

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Youth and Group Areas, Fishing, Picnicking, Restrooms, and Playgrounds.  
**Directions:** South on Route 24 from the Riverhead Traffic Circle, turn left onto County Road 105, go over bridge, entrance is on the right, past the golf course.

**9 SEARS BELLOWES COUNTY PARK**  
Hampton Bays (631) 852-8290

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Fishing, Horseback Riding Trails, Picnicking, Boating, Nature Trails, Restrooms and Playground.  
**Directions:** Sunrise Highway to Exit 65 North, make a left on Bellows Pond Road. Entrance is on the right.

**10 CEDAR POINT COUNTY PARK**  
East Hampton (631) 852-7620

**Facilities Include:** Camping, Boating, Youth and Group Areas, Fishing, Restrooms, Outer Beach Area, and Playground.  
**Directions:** East on Montauk Highway, left onto Stephen Hands Path. North on Old Northwest Road. Follow signs to Alewife Brook Road and park entrance.
