CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 68-2012, HISTORIC TRUST RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING THE DEDICATION OF PROSSER PINES COUNTY PARK AND ASSOCIATED BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY HISTORIC TRUST

WHEREAS, Resolution 871-1972 established the Suffolk County Historic Trust and designated the voting members of the Council on Environmental Quality as its membership; and

WHEREAS, Article I §C1-4 of the Suffolk County Charter states that a function of the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality is to make recommendations to the County Legislature and County Executive as to what County-owned properties should be dedicated to the Historic Trust; and

WHEREAS, Article I §C1-8 of the Suffolk County Charter authorizes the County to dedicate properties having distinctive historical significance to the Historic Trust; and

WHEREAS, the subject property was an early Suffolk County farmstead with on-site elements dating back to the late 1700's with a grove of White Pine trees planted by William Dayton in 1812, now known as Prosser Pines; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County acquired the approximately 56 acre property for County park purposes in 1968; and

WHEREAS, the Prosser Pines County Park property was originally dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust by Suffolk County resolution 311-1984. However, at that time the buildings and structures within the park were not included in the dedication; and

WHEREAS, at this time it is recommended that the dedication be clarified to include the historic buildings and structures on site in addition to the land on which they reside; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Trust Committee has recommended to the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality, as the Suffolk County Historic Trust that Prosser Pines County Park and associated buildings and structures be dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust for preservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, at its December 12, 2012 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality reviewed and considered information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, Division of Historic Services; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that a quorum of the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality, as the Suffolk County Historic Trust hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the subject property outlined below be dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust as so indicated pursuant to the Historic Trust Manual

RE: CEQ Review of the Proposed Acquisition of Land for Open Space Preservation Purposes Known as the Mastic/Shirley Conservation Area Kramer Property, Town of Brookhaven

At its December 12, 2012 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and based on the information received, as well as that given in a presentation by Laretta Fischer, Principal Environmental Analyst with the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning, the Council advises the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, in CEQ Resolution No. 70-2012, a copy of which is attached, that the proposed project be considered an Unlisted Action under SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment.

If the Legislature concurs with the Council on Environmental Quality's recommendation that the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, the Presiding Officer should cause to be brought before the Legislature for a vote, a resolution determining that the proposed action is an Unlisted Action pursuant to SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment (negative declaration). However, if the Legislature has further environmental concerns regarding this project and needs additional information, the Presiding Officer should remand the case back to the initiating unit for the necessary changes to the project and EAF or submit a resolution authorizing the initiating unit to prepare a draft environmental impact statement (positive declaration).

Please note that the Council felt that this purchase was not worthy of acquisition as the property is developed on an extremely flood-prone area and not included on the Suffolk County Master List of acquisitions. WHEREAS, at its December 12, 2012 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning; and

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. the proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.7 which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
2. the proposed use of the subject parcel(s) is passive recreation;
3. if not acquired, the property could technically be developed under existing zoning; incurring far greater environmental impact than the proposed acquisition and preservation of the site would have; and be it further;
4. the on-site structure will be properly removed with an asbestos survey completed in accordance with New York State Department of Labor Industrial Code 56 prior to the property being transferred to the jurisdiction of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation;
5. the private water supply well serving the property will be properly abandoned in accordance with all applicable regulations prior to the property being transferred to the jurisdiction of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation; and, be it further

4th RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).

WHEREAS, at its December 12, 2012 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by Laretta Fischer, Principal Environmental Analyst with the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning, as well as Dave Genaway, Planning Commissioner with the Town of Islip; and

WHEREAS, the project involves the acquisition of 14.06 ± acres of land by Suffolk County for active recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Islip has adopted a Resolution committing to the development and maintenance of the property as active parkland either through the use of cooperative agreements with a viable third party sports organization and/or civic organization, or directly through the efforts of its own Departments; now, therefore, be it

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. the proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.7 which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form; and
2. if not acquired, the property will most likely be developed for residential purposes; incurring far greater environmental impact than the proposed acquisition and recreational development of the site would have; and
3. a vegetated buffer shall be installed to the greatest extent practicable on the southern border of the property adjacent to the residential development;
4. bike lanes shall be considered and installed on the site access if they can be accommodated;

5. no lighting shall be installed to illuminate the fields for night activities;
 6. natural vegetated buffers shall be retained to the greatest extent practicable;
 7. security fencing shall be installed on the northern border of the property adjacent to the Long Island Rail Road right-of-way;
 8. bicycle racks shall be installed on site to accommodate and encourage non-motorized transportation;
 9. The Town of Islip, as the operator of the facility shall address the severity of the traffic impacts by limiting the number of games to be played on any given day and requiring the timing of the games be staggered so that the trips from all three fields are not exiting and entering the facility at once;
 10. All development on site shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable Suffolk County Department of Public Works permits and the Suffolk County Sanitary Code;

3rd RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).
