RE: CEQ Review of the Proposed Compensatory Wetland Mitigation Project at Lakeland County Park

---

At its March 23, 2015 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and based on the information received, as well as that given in a presentation by representatives from the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation & Conservation and the Long Island Rail Road, the Council advises the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, in CEQ Resolution No. 09-2015, a copy of which is attached, that the proposed project be considered an Unlisted Action under SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment.

If the Legislature concurs with the Council on Environmental Quality's recommendation that the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, the Presiding Officer should cause to be brought before the Legislature for a vote, a resolution determining that the proposed action is an Unlisted Action pursuant to SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment (negative declaration). However, if the Legislature has further environmental concerns regarding this project and needs additional information, the Presiding Officer should remand the case back to the initiating unit for the necessary changes to the project and EAF or submit a resolution authorizing the initiating unit to prepare a draft environmental impact statement (positive declaration).

**CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 09-2015, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR A COMPENSATORY WETLAND MITIGATION PROJECT AT LAKELAND COUNTY PARK**

**WHEREAS**, at its March 23, 2015 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation & Conservation; and

**WHEREAS**, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by representatives from the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation & Conservation and the Long Island Rail Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed action involves a compensatory wetland mitigation project at Lakeland County Park pursuant to a Freshwater Wetlands Permit issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the United States Army Corps of Engineers; and

**WHEREAS**, said wetland project involves the installation of a culvert and retaining wall and the filling of a maximum of 0.14 acres of wetlands in the Long Island Rail Road right-of-way adjacent to Lakeland County Park and a compensatory wetland mitigation project in two locations within Lakeland County Park resulting in the enhancement of approximately 0.15 acres of wetlands, the enhancement of approximately 0.22 adjacent acres and the construction of a 0.05 acre boardwalk; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed action is part of the LIRR's overall "Second Track Project" aka "the Double Track" where a second continuous railroad track is constructed within the LIRR owned right-of-way over a 17.9 mile segment of the Ronkonkoma Branch between Farmingdale and Ronkonkoma LIRR train stations; and

**WHEREAS**, the LIRR conducted a Coordinated SEQRA Review of the overall LIRR Second Track Project and on October 3, 2013 determined that the project would not have any significant adverse environmental impacts; now, therefore, be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed wetlands mitigation project be classified as an Unlisted Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed action will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. the proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.7 which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;

2. the proposed action does not appear to significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York of the Suffolk County Charter and Code;
3. the access roads proposed to be used by the LIRR already exist and the use of said access road will be temporary in nature;
4. the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) has issued a Permit for the proposed wetlands project;
5. prior to construction Suffolk County Parks, Recreation and Conservation and the LIRR will carefully examine the construction elements and consider employing appropriate engineered products for the proposed boardwalk;

and, be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).
