RE: CEQ Review of the Proposed Replacement of Smith Point Bridge and Associated Roadways, Town of Brookhaven

At its May 18, 2016 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and based on the information received, as well as that given in a presentation by Paul McMahon, Principal Civil Engineer, Suffolk County Department of Public Works and Bill Nyman, Project Manager for Hardesty and Hanover, the Council advises the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, in CEQ Resolution No. 19-2016, a copy of which is attached, that the proposed project be considered a Type I Action under SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment.

If the Legislature concurs with the Council on Environmental Quality's recommendation that the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, the Presiding Officer should cause to be brought before the Legislature for a vote, a resolution determining that the proposed action is a Type I Action pursuant to SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment (negative declaration). However, if the Legislature has further environmental concerns regarding this project and needs additional information, the Presiding Officer should remand the case back to the initiating unit for the necessary changes to the project and EAF or submit a resolution authorizing the initiating unit to prepare a draft environmental impact statement (positive declaration).

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 19-2016, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR THE PROPOSED REPLACEMENT OF SMITH POINT BRIDGE AND ASSOCIATED ROADWAYS, TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN

WHEREAS, at its May 18, 2016 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by Suffolk County Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by Paul McMahon, Principal Civil Engineer for the Suffolk County Department of Public Works and Bill Nyman, Project Manager for Hardesty and Hanover; and

WHEREAS, the project involves the proposed replacement of the Smith Point Bridge and associated roadways to address major structural and operational deficiencies with the existing bridge; and

WHEREAS, the proposed replacement bridge will be constructed on a new alignment located west of the existing bridge and would include two motor vehicle travel lanes, two ADA compliant sidewalks and two shoulders which would allow bike travel; and

WHEREAS, the proposed replacement bridge will be a fixed level bridge with a 55.5 feet clearance over the navigation channel; and

WHEREAS, after construction of the new bridge is completed the existing bridge will be removed; now, therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as a Type I Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria in Section 617.7 of Title 6 NYCRR which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
2. The proposal does not appear to significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and Code;
3. Proposed construction activities will not restrict access to Smith Point County Park/Fire Island National Seashore and are not anticipated to result in a significant impact on traffic circulation in and around the project area;

4. The proposed bridge will improve pedestrian and bicycle access to Smith Point County Park/Fire Island National Seashore;
5. The proposed bridge and approaches will meet current NYSDEC rules and regulations for stormwater management and will eliminate any direct stormwater discharge to the Great South Bay/Narrow Bay;
6. The majority of pile driving for the proposed bridge and the mechanical demolition of the existing bridge is planned to occur between December and March to minimize impacts to the marine habitat;
7. The proposed project will employ silt curtains and cofferdams during in-water construction and demolition work to reduce resuspension of bottom sediments and minimize impacts to water quality and the marine habitat;
8. The proposed project includes wetlands restoration and compensatory wetlands mitigation which will be implemented in coordination with the NYSDEC, USACE, NPS and/or USFWS;
9. The project sponsors will coordinate with Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation to replace displaced recreational facilities in Smith Point County Park;
10. All necessary permits/approvals will be obtained from all applicable federal, state, county and local regulatory agencies prior to the commencement of the bridge replacement project;

3rd RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 20-2016, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY SANITARY CODE TO ALLOW FOR THE PERMITTING, REGISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF INNOVATIVE AND ALTERNATIVE ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, at its May 18, 2016 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by Suffolk County Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by Christopher Lubicich, Principal Public Health Engineer with the Suffolk County Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Department of Health Services (Department) proposes to create a new Article 19 of the Suffolk County Sanitary Code titled "Management of Innovative and Alternative Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (I/A OWTS)"; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Article 19 describes I/A OWTS as onsite wastewater treatment technologies that are accepted by the Department as capable of achieving total nitrogen concentrations that are less than Conventional Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Article 19 will authorize the Department to function as a Responsible Management Entity of all I/A OWTS installed within Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, as a Responsible Management Entity, the Department will be responsible to promulgate standards to ensure the long term operation, maintenance, and management of all I/A OWTS; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as a Type I Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria in 6 N.Y.C.R.R. § 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant adverse impacts on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
2. There are no significant adverse impacts to groundwater associated with the proposed Article 19, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form. Article 19 allows for the approval, registration, and management of all I/A OWTS. I/A OWTS are designed to achieve a greater reduction in total nitrogen (TN), biological oxygen demand (BOD), and total suspended solids (TSS) than that of a Conventional Onsite Wastewater Treatment System which are currently allowed under existing Sanitary Code;

3. There are no significant adverse impacts to surface water associated with Article 19, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form. Article 19 allows for the approval, registration, and management of all I/A OWTS. I/A OWTS are designed to achieve a greater reduction in total nitrogen (TN), biological oxygen demand (BOD), and total suspended solids (TSS) than that of a Conventional Onsite Wastewater Treatment System which are currently allowed under existing Sanitary Code. The ability to install I/A OWTS in coastal areas will provide an alternative to the existing septic tank and leaching pool systems currently required under existing Sanitary Code and Standards;
4. I/A OWTS are not being required under Article 19. They will be allowed as an acceptable alternative to conventional systems and have to be managed and sampled to ensure continued performance;
5. There are no changes to density requirements under Article 19. Article 19 will not change existing land use;
6. The first sentence in the Proposed Article 19, Declaration of Policy Section will be clarified to include food production as a key use for Suffolk County's groundwater and the propagation of natural resources as a key consideration in the utilization and management of Suffolk County's surface water;
7. I/A OWTS are a proven alternative to Conventional Septic Systems and are capable of significant nitrogen reduction; and, be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).

WHEREAS, at its May 18, 2016 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by Laretta Fischer, Chief Environmental Analyst, with the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning; and

WHEREAS, the project involves the proposed 2016 Suffolk County Agricultural District Modifications; and
