NOTICE OF SEQRA PUBLIC SCOPING HEARING

Notice is hereby given that Suffolk County will convene a SEQRA public scoping hearing concerning the Suffolk County Sewer Capacity Study to receive comments on development of a Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement for a feasibility study to evaluate sewage infrastructure needs, costs and benefits associated with the construction of sanitary sewage collection and treatment systems for the seven currently unsewered areas of Bellport, Sayville, Ronkonkoma Hub, Middle Island Corridor, Mastic/Shirley, Yaphank and Southampton. The hearing will be held at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 26, 2011 at Brookhaven Town Hall, One Independence Hill, Farmingville. Pursuant to the Citizens Public Participation Act, all citizens are invited to submit testimony, either orally or in writing at the meeting.
