This application form may not be used for enhanced nitrogen removal septic systems. A separate application form will be available for upgrades of individual onsite sanitary systems, and for systems which comply with Appendix A of SCDHS Commercial Construction Standards, which currently allow for advanced subsurface nitrogen removal for flows of up to 15,000 gpd (as of April 2013) for commercial projects or residential clusters (1,000 gpd or greater).
