Sealed bids will be received at the Office of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, (Room 103), 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, until 11:00 AM local time on **March 22, 2012** at which time they will be publicly opened and read for:

Project Title: **SD No. 3, BERGEN POINT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
SCREENING ROOM ODOR CONTROL**

Location: West Babylon, New York

Capital Project No. **8170**

This Project consists of: demolition of existing equipment, piping and ductwork within the Influent Screenings Building of the Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant; outside installation of a packed-bed multi-staged chemical odor control scrubber system and chemical storage tanks, including all associated sitework, masonry/concrete structures; new ductwork, piping and valves; new fans, motorized louvers; removal and replacement of AHU and UH heating system components; electrical and control work, all as shown and/or specified in the Contract Documents.

Note: This project will be bid as a multiple prime contract, as follows:

CONTRACT NO. 1 - GENERAL CONSTRUCTION

CONTRACT NO. 2 - HVAC

CONTRACT NO. 3 - ELECTRICAL

IMPORTANT: Prospective bidders are advised that there will be ongoing work within the Influent Screenings building that may affect the manner and/or timeframe in which work under this contract can be undertaken. All contractors will be expected to comply with the provisions of this contract as they relate to coordination with other contracts and cooperation amongst all parties to facilitate safe and expedient implementation of the work. Additional information regarding this matter is contained in Section 01040 of the Technical Specifications.

Contract Documents, including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Specimen Agreement, General Conditions, Specifications, Drawings and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Offices of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, Room 103, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, between the hours of 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on or after **February 24, 2012**.

IMPORTANT: In order to submit a bid and be eligible for award, bidders MUST purchase a bid set of Contract Documents from Suffolk County. A payment of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in the form of a check or money order will be required for each full set of Contract Documents. Checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer." *Cash will not be accepted.*

IMPORTANT: Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and Proposal Forms: Company Name, Address, Telephone and FAX Number, E-Mail Address, and Federal ID Number. **Note: This information should represent the contact name and address to which any Addenda should be sent.**

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets. Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. No refund will be made on sets that are not returned within this period.

A Pre-bid meeting and site visit will be held on March 7, 2012, at 9:00 AM at the Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant in West Babylon.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. The bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administration Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person by the Bidder or his agent at the time and place stated.

NOTE: Notice to Bidders and Bid Results are posted on the Suffolk County Web Site at <http://www.suffolkcountyny.gov>. Go to Department Directory link and scroll down menu and choose Public Works. Then click on Bids and Contracts. Bid Results will not be given out over the telephone. You are requested to access the County website for this information. If you are not in attendance at the bid opening, please be patient while we process and post the results. Results will typically be posted within 24 hours after the bid opening.

Please note that all construction projects over \$250,000 advertised after July 17, 2008 will be subject to training requirements pursuant to Section 220-h of the NYS labor Law.

The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
