NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, (Room 132), 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, until 11:00 AM local time on **August 25, 2011** at which time they will be publicly opened and read for:

**SUFFOLK COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 3  
BERGEN POINT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT INFLUENT PUMP STATION  
BUTTERFLY VALVE REPLACEMENT  
CAPITAL PROJECT NO. CP 8170**

- A. The purpose of the project is to replace the eight (8) rectangular butterfly valves located in the main influent pumping station and install the complete hydraulic actuation system for the valve operation at the Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant owned by Suffolk County.
- B. This abbreviated summary is provided in order to acquaint the bidder with the work covered by the Contract Documents for Contract Capital Project 8170. It is not all inclusive of the work under the Contract. The Work includes, but is not limited to, the following:
1. Install temporary dikes to isolate channels and work areas. Pump out and clean work areas as required for valve replacement.
  2. Demolition and removal of the existing butterfly valves including the frames, discs and electric actuators.
  3. Preparation of and refinishing of the existing concrete channel floors and walls as required for the installation of the new valves.
  4. Furnish and install the new butterfly frames and disks.
  5. Furnish and install the complete hydraulic actuation system including the power unit, accumulator, connecting piping, electric connections and indicators, electrical connection to the plant SCADA system. and required items not supplied by the valve manufacturer.
  6. Startup participation for the various equipment and systems of the project and provide complete service to troubleshoot and assist manufacturer service representatives in obtaining a completely functional installation.
  7. Project closeout submittals.
  8. All other work shown and specified within the Contract Documents.

- C. All floors of the influent channel side of the influent pump station are considered **Permit – Required Confined spaces**. Any entry into these spaces must conform to the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) 1910.46 requirements including the following:
1. The Contractor shall develop and implement a written permit space program that complies with section 1910.146(c) for entry into the influent pump station channels.
  2. All entrants, attendants and supervisors shall have full knowledge of their duties as defined in 1910.146.
  3. Lockout/Tagout required on all equipment.

Note: This project will be bid as a multiple prime contract. Contract Documents, including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Specimen Agreement, General Conditions, Specifications, Drawings and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Offices of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, Room 132, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, between the hours of 9:30AM and 3:30PM daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on or after **July 14, 2011**. *Eligible bidders must have obtained bid documents from the Suffolk County Department of Public Works Purchasing Unit.*

A deposit of one hundred dollars and no cents (\$100.00) in the form of a check will be required for one full set of Contract Documents. Deposit checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer." Cash will not be accepted.

A mandatory pre-Bid Meeting and site walk through is scheduled for **August 4, 2011** at 10:00 AM at the Suffolk County Sewer District No. 3 Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant, 600 Bergen Avenue, West Babylon, New York 11763. Sign-in will be in the main lobby of the administration building located in the front of the plant. A second non-informational/non-mandatory site walk through will be scheduled for **August 18, 2011** at 10:00 AM.

Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and Proposal Forms: Company Name, Address, Telephone and FAX Number, E-Mail Address, and Federal ID Number.

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets.

Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. Deposit on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. The bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administration Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person by the Bidder or his agent at the time and place stated.

Then click on Bids and Contracts. Bid Results will not be given out over the telephone. You are requested to access the County website for this information. If you are not in attendance at the bid opening, please be patient while we process and post the results. Results will typically be posted within 24 hours after the bid opening.

Please note that all construction projects over \$250,000 advertised after July 17, 2008 will be subject to training requirements pursuant to Section 220-h of the NYS labor Law.

The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
