***Legislator Hahn to Call for Immediate Approval as Suffolk Legislature Consider Statute

Long Island Expressway:

Take the LIE east to Exit 71/Montauk-Riverhead-County Center/Edwards Avenue/Route 24. Make a right turn onto NYS Route24/CR 94 and go 4 miles. You will pass the Sheriff's Office and SC Correctional Facility. At Center Drive, make a right (the sign says "Suffolk County Offices"). The legislative auditorium is in the Evans K.
