Patchogue, LI—Friday, July 13: All were on hand for the demolition of the old Nessenger Chevrolet building located on Montauk Highway in East Patchogue. The town of Brookhaven has plans to turn the parcel into passive parkland with trails while Leg. Calarco has already passed a resolution to acquire the four-acre wooded parcel adjacent to the Nessenger property.

“This is another great day for East Patchogue and another step forward in local government’s initiative to fight blight. My goal is to acquire the adjacent four acres of property across the Swan River for the purpose of converting it to passive parkland and to enhance what the town is doing at the Nessenger site,” said Leg. Calarco.
