Lt. Michael Murphy Sea Cadets join Legislator Lindsay, and other County Officials to establish permanent relationship with the Long Island Maritime Museum County Executive Bellone to Sign Resolution into Law

WHAT: Suffolk County Legislator Bill Lindsay III will be joined by his colleagues on the legislature and members of the Lt. Michael Murphy Division of the United States Naval Sea Cadet Corps as County Executive Steve Bellone signs a bill authorizing the County and the Long Island Maritime Museum to establish a permanent relationship with the Sea Cadets. This authorization will allow the Sea Cadets to utilize and improve existing structures on the Museum grounds so they can offer their program on an ongoing basis and foster public appreciation for maritime and naval history. A rendition of the Star Spangled Banner will also be performed in honor of both the song's 200th Anniversary and Flag Day.
