Local Police Officer, Jamie Atkinson, Honored as International Association of Financial Crime Investigator's "Member of the Year"

(HAUPPAUGE)- Legislator Bill Lindsay recently awarded MTA Police Officer Jamie Atkinson with a special Proclamation at last month's General Meeting, in response to having won the

“2015 Member of the Year Award” for the International Association of Financial Crime Investigators.

Atkinson has been a decorated police officer for the MTA Police Department since 2002. He has investigated several complex financial fraud and identity theft cases involving financial losses to the MTA, Long Island Rail Road, and its 85 million annual rider, in over a million dollars that were committed through credit card, financial institutions, fraudulent documents, skimming devices and online fraud.

This resulted in multiple arrests for the production of fraudulent LIRR tickets, student passes, credit cards, and has apprehended suspects in bank robberies and other crimes.

“Atkinson continuously goes above and beyond the call of duty,” said Lindsay, “...which truly makes him an outstanding advocate for the MTA Police Department and for all Suffolk County residents alike.”

Atkinson is also an active member of his community, serving as the volunteer Ex-Chief of the Community Ambulance Company and as a Board of Director, holds the title of Safety and Emergency Management Officer for the North Shore LIJ Health System, is a Board of Director for the Youth Enrichment Services, and sits on the Suffolk County Citizen’s Corp Council.
