Suffolk County Legislator Tom Barraga (R-West Islip) recently had the pleasure of meeting with Elizabeth Geary and Lori Maldavir of the Community Program Center (CPC) of Long Island to discuss the outlook for CPC in 2013.

CPC is a not-for-profit organization innovative in offering shared-site intergenerational day care. They are entering their 33rd year of service and continue to be a reliable community resource for working families. Their child care and learning program, Early Discoveries center, offers school age care and is contracted with local school districts to provide Universal pre-Kindergarten.

In response to the needs of family caregivers for support services CPC's Day Haven Adult Day services provides a five-day a week, full-time, adult day services structured program filled with activities for physically frail older adults and those with dementia. They also offer caregiver services which include support groups, educational events and management services.

In 1984 CPC began a federally funded Head Start program which now operates year-round servicing 10+ school districts in central Suffolk County. Eligibility is based on low-income.
