SUPER STORM SANDY CHARITABLE WORK**

Restaurant Prepared Hundreds of Meals for Residents, First Responders after Storm

HUNTINGTON, NY –Suffolk County Legislator Steve Stern (D-Huntington) 16th LD awarded Miller's Deer Park Ale House General Manager Devon with a Proclamation for its dedicated efforts to aid our community in the aftermath of Super Storm Sandy.

In the days immediately following the storm, the Ale House opened its doors to the community to provide meals and comfort for people without power and also served hundreds of meals to residents sheltering at Robert Frost Middle School and first responders at the Deer Park Fire Department.

The Ale House also prepared 300 Thanksgiving meals for Lindenhurst residents and served a Thanksgiving dinner at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church. For Christmas, the Ale House staff helped collect toys for children affected by the storm with Camp Bulldog in Lindenhurst.
