LEGISLATOR STEVE STERN AWARDS SECOND PRECINCT "TOP COP"

Police Officer Harry Jos Honored at Half Hollow Hills High School West Pre-Prom Meeting

HUNTINGTON, NY –Suffolk County Legislator Steve Stern (D-Huntington) 16th LD presented a Proclamation to Second Precinct “Top Cop” Harry Jos at the Pre-Prom meeting at Half Hollow Hills High School West. Officer Jos is an 18 year veteran and has earned five Departmental Commendations, one Command Commendation, two letters of recognition, five Excellent Police Duty Awards and has twice been named the Second Precinct’s “Cop of the Month.” In addition, he was named a “Top Cop” for DWI arrests in 2012 at the annual “STOP-DWI Top Cop” award ceremony.

Legislator Stern spoke to students and parents attending a mandatory Pre-Prom meeting about the dangers of drinking and driving.
