ELWOOD PUBLIC LIBRARY**

Elwood Public Library was founded in 2004 when the community voted to create a community library to serve its growing needs. The library's first home was a 3,000-square-foot building on Jericho Turnpike. In March 2009, the library tripled its size in a move to its current location at the corner of Jericho Turnpike and Elwood Road.

Over the past 10 years, Elwood Public Library has become the center of the community with exceptional programs for pre-school children, students and adults in a beautiful facility with computers, meeting rooms, activities and a comprehensive collection of items available to the community.
