HUNTINGTON, NY- Suffolk County Legislator Steve Stern (D-Huntington) 16th L.D., Chairman of the Veterans and Seniors Committee, is advising veterans that Suffolk County Community College (SCCC) will be hosting the SCCC Veterans' Career Conference—Empowering the Defenders of Our Freedom on Friday, April 10, 2015, at the SCCC Health, Education and Sports Center, Room105, 1001 Crooked Hill Road, from 9:00 am- 4:00 pm.
