## ***Legislator Fleming Recognizes Montauk's 12<sup>th</sup> Eagle Scout***

(Montauk, NY) – Suffolk County Legislator Bridget Fleming joined the family and friends of Brendan Snow at the Montauk Fire House on Sunday, January 10<sup>th</sup> to recognize his achievement of the highest scouting rank, the Eagle Award. Snow is only the 12th Scout from Montauk to become an Eagle; only 3% of Scouts nation-wide achieve this status.

In order to become an Eagle Scout, Snow orchestrated a service project to build bleachers at the Montauk School baseball field. Additionally, Snow earned 26 merit badges and served Troop 136 as Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader, and Troop Guide.
