**Woman suspected in 2 bank robberies to be arraigned on indictment tomorrow in Riverhead**

A 44 year old Bayport woman who is a suspect in two West Babylon bank robberies will be arraigned on an indictment tomorrow (4/22/2015) in Riverhead, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Julia Rigby, 44, of 62 Nelson Avenue, allegedly held up the NYCB Bank on West Main in West Babylon on April 10 and the HSBC Bank on Farmingville Road in West Babylon on April 2. She passed notes written on envelopes to tellers in each robbery demanding \$10,000 in cash.

She was arrested after a brief chase when Suffolk police saw her 2001 Ford Taurus in the vicinity of Hubbard's Path in West Babylon.

Pattern Crime Unit detectives are investigating whether Rigby is responsible for other recent bank robberies in Suffolk County. She is incarcerated in the county jail in lieu of \$80,000 cash bail.

State Supreme Court Justice Mark Cohen will unseal Rigby's indictment. The calendar will be called at 9:30 am.
