Getaway driver for Suffolk robbery spree to be sentenced in Riverhead

A Medford woman convicted of her role in the commission of more than a dozen armed robberies in Suffolk County with her boyfriend a year ago will be sentenced tomorrow (Tuesday, January 6, 2015) in Riverhead, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Jamie Greco, 24, was the getaway driver for Christopher Marino, 30, when the pair worked together to rob fast-food restaurants, gas stations and an ice cream store in Lake Ronkonkoma, Ronkonkoma, Nesconset, Medford, North Patchogue and Patchogue from Dec. 9, 2013 to Jan. 7, 2014.

Marino was sentenced last month to ten years in state prison.

During the investigation, District Attorney Spota said, Suffolk Police Pattern Crime detectives established the couple was spending the stolen cash on heroin.

Greco is expected to be sentenced to three years in state prison by Judge Stephen Braslow (third floor of the courthouse) for pleading guilty to attempted robbery charges. The court calendar will be called at 9:30 am.
