Second indictment for woman charged in east end fraud

A 63 year old suspect, described in published reports as a “high society con woman”, will be arraigned tomorrow (Tuesday January 4) in Suffolk County court in Riverhead on a second indictment for allegedly defrauding east end businesses.

Nydia Vega has been incarcerated in the Suffolk County jail on an indictment for issuing bad checks to her landlord and at least a half-dozen east end businesses in May of 2009.

Ms. Vega has several aliases, including Nydia Neubauer, Nydia Vega Reeves, Nydia Rothschild, and Lucy George.

The defendant was arrested in Monmouth County New Jersey in September for skipping out on a dinner tab.

Judge Martin Efman will unseal the indictment. The calendar will be called at 9:30 am.
