## **Suspect arraigned for mobile home park robbery and assault**

A homeless woman who robbed a tenant in a Riverhead mobile home park on New Years day pleaded not guilty at her arraignment in Suffolk Criminal court this afternoon.

Julia Townsend, 38, allegedly assaulted a male Glenwood Village resident around 3:00 am after pushing in the door. She fled the scene with cash and jewelry.

She is charged with one count of first degree burglary, one count of second degree robbery and one count of assault in the second degree. State Supreme Court Justice C. Randall Hinrichs set bail at \$100,000 cash or \$200,000 bond.
