21-year sentence for Deer Park man convicted of murder and violent assault

State Supreme Court Justice Robert W. Doyle sentenced Alex Aguilar of Deer Park to 21 years in prison today for fatally stabbing one man and shooting a teenager in Brentwood in June and July of 2009.

Aguilar shot Wilson Battista Jr. in the head on June 15, 2009 in Timberline Park, seriously injuring the then-13 year old, and on July 20, 2009, stabbed 28 year old Edgar Villalobos to death on Patton Street.

The defendant received concurrent sentences of 21 years for second degree murder and first degree assault.

Because of the violent felony convictions, the defendant, a documented immigrant from El Salvador, is subject to deportation at the conclusion of his incarceration.
