Sentencing Tuesday for Huntington Station homicide

A Huntington Station man will be sentenced in Suffolk County court tomorrow for the shooting death of 38 year old Geremias Caceres at the intersection of 10th Ave. and West 15th Street in Huntington Station in 2010.

Ralph Guerrier, 26, attempted to rob Caceres near the victim's home. In October a jury convicted Guerrier of one count of second degree murder and first degree attempted robbery.

Suffolk District Attorney Thomas Spota said the district attorney's office will make a sentencing recommendation that Guerrier serve the maximum 25 years to life in prison.

Codefendant Gni Brown, 20, testified for the prosecution during Guerrier's trial and will serve 15 years to life in state prison.

Judge Mark Cohen (fourth floor of the courthouse) will call the court calendar at 9:30 am. The sentencing is not expected to occur before 10:30 am.
