
16 years to life for domestic violence

A Deer Park man was sentenced today to 16 years to life in prison for attacking his estranged girlfriend in a Brentwood home last year.

Calvin Goodbread, 33, used a wooden post from a fence to beat the victim. After a two week trial, Goodbread was convicted of Burglary in the Second Degree, Aggravated Criminal Contempt, Criminal Contempt in the First Degree, Assault in the Third Degree, Obstructing Governmental Administration in the Second Degree, Resisting Arrest and Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree.

Goodbread violated an order of protection issued in Suffolk district court in 2009.

District Attorney Thomas Spota said state department of corrections records indicate the defendant had at least five previous felony convictions.
