Burglary suspect to be arraigned tomorrow

A 46 year old burglary suspect will be arraigned Wednesday in Suffolk County court in Riverhead.

Sandra Kurschner of Dorsett Place, Shirley is the suspect in eleven house burglaries. Homes on Smith Street, Northern Boulevard, Olive Lane, Mastic Boulevard, Francine Place, and Park Circle were broken into between May and September of this year. Police arrested Kurschner on October 12.

Jewelry, laptop computers, cash, and a flat screen television were among the items stolen from the homes.
