Grand Jury indicts alleged child molester; arraignment of suspect today in Riverhead

A West Hempstead man arrested last month for allegedly having sex with a teenage boy he met on the internet will be arraigned on a grand jury indictment on Friday, September 21 in Suffolk criminal court in Riverhead.

Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said police charged David Boutin of West Hempstead, a financial planner, with two counts of second-degree criminal sexual act.

A police officer searching for a stolen motor bike on the afternoon of August 17 discovered Boutin, 42, and the 13 year old victim in the backseat of the defendant's car parked on a remote utility access road in the Wading River/Shoreham area.

District Attorney Spota said Boutin began communicating with the teen through the Craigslist website in April of this year.

Judge Barbara Kahn (second floor of the courthouse) will unseal the indictment. Calendar call is scheduled for 9:30 am.
