Bay Shore man arraigned on murder charges

A 30 year old Bay Shore man pleaded not guilty today at his arraignment on a charge of murder alleging he shot 26-year-old Alexander P. Incorvia to death behind a shuttered K-Mart store in Middle Island, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Defendant Michael K. Dirkschneider of 8 Diamond Street is charged with murder in the first degree, murder in the second degree, criminal possession of a weapon in the second degree and criminal possession of a weapon in the third degree.

Suffolk County police recovered a .45 caliber handgun, believed to be the murder weapon, from Dirkschneider's dresser on April 2 and arrested him on a weapons charge. A grand jury indicted Dirkschneider for the homicide last Friday, District Attorney Spota said.

Incorvia's body was found by a woman walking her dog in the wooded area behind the vacant store on April 2. The victim was shot multiple times.
