Suspect arraigned for Patchogue sex assault and robbery

Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota today announced the arraignment of a 25 year old Patchogue man for criminal sexual act in the first degree and robbery in the second degree.

Gary Grigg of 265 W Main Street in Patchogue - on parole for a 2008 burglary - allegedly attacked the female victim around 3:15 AM on June 29 on West Main Street in Patchogue.

"Grigg has been indicted on one charge of criminal sexual act in the first degree and robbery in the second degree," District Attorney Spota said. "This was a vicious crime and the victim is suffering from both the trauma of the violence she endured, and from cuts, bruises, and a broken nose as she valiantly resisted."

County Court Judge Barbara Kahn set bail at \$500,000 cash.

Grigg's next court date is September 10, 2013.
