## **Suspect in Stony Brook rape indicted**

20 year old Patrick O'Sullivan will appear in Suffolk County court today for arraignment on a grand jury indictment, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

O'Sullivan was arrested for a sexual assault in a Stony Brook home last month.

Police said the East Moriches man, armed with a loaded .22 caliber rifle, entered the house through an unlocked door, sexually assaulted the victim, and left with computers and a camera.

The defendant is incarcerated in the Suffolk County jail in lieu of one million dollars cash bail.

County Judge Barbara Kahn will unseal the indictment. The court calendar will be called at 9:30 AM.
