## **Huntington Station pair indicted on drugs and weapons possession charges**

Two Huntington Station men arrested on drugs and weapons charges will appear in court in Riverhead tomorrow (Tuesday, December 23) to be arraigned on an indictment, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

During the execution of a search warrant December 11<sup>th</sup> at the residence on Lowndes Avenue, Samuel Spells, 32, a five-time prior felon on parole, tried to escape by jumping onto the roof outside his bedroom. Spells had five loaded guns including a handgun near his bed and an assault weapon with an attachment for a high capacity ammunition feeding device in his room. Second precinct detectives also seized cocaine, a scale, and packaging materials found in his room.

Kareem Walters, 32, was also on parole at the time of his arrest on December 11. In Walters' first floor living quarters' detectives' recovered a handgun, cocaine, a scale and two dishes used in the manufacturing of crack. Walters is a two-time prior felony offender.

The detectives "entered a potentially very violent situation and seized a total of six loaded weapons, ammunition, cocaine and cash," District Attorney Spota said.

Spells and Walters will appear before State Supreme Court Justice Marc Cohen (fourth floor of the courthouse) tomorrow morning. The court calendar will be called at 9:30.
