Murder suspect indicted for Deer Park homicide

The 23 year old Brentwood man arrested by Suffolk homicide detectives last week for shooting one man to death and wounding another will be arraigned tomorrow in Riverhead on a grand jury indictment Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Jhamek Daniels, 23, of Brentwood is incarcerated without bail and charged with murder in the second degree and attempted murder in the second degree. Daniels allegedly opened fire on the parked car the victims Jean Yves and Javonne Mimms were in outside the Night Owl Lounge in Deer Park around 2 AM the morning of January 16, 2014.

Yves, of Wyandanch, died of his injuries, Mimms survived serious wounds.

Judge Richard Ambro will unseal the indictment. The court calendar begins at 9:30 am.
