Sentencing Wednesday in Central Islip for drunk driver in fatal crash

A Shirley man who was drunk when he lost control of his car and hit a tree in Brentwood last year, killing his passenger, will be sentenced tomorrow (2/18) in Central Islip, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Oscar Rivera was driving a 2000 Lincoln southbound on Grand Boulevard when he crossed over Noble Street, and struck a tree in front of 250 Grand Boulevard at around 6 on the morning of October 4, 2014.

His passenger, David N. Gonzalez, 29, of Brentwood was pronounced dead at Southside Hospital in Bay Shore.

Rivera pleaded guilty to vehicular manslaughter in the second degree, driving while intoxicated and driving without a license.
