Alleged DWI driver who crashed into police cars to be arraigned Wednesday

A Farmingville man arrested for DWI in May after crashing into two Suffolk County police cars will be arraigned on an indictment tomorrow, Wednesday, July 13, in Central Islip, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Jonathan Kunstadt of Farmingville crashed into the police vehicles while the two officers were assisting a disabled motorist on the William Floyd Parkway in Shirley at 3:30 in the morning on May 8 of this year.

One officer was treated for minor injuries; the other police officer was not injured.

A passenger in Kunstadt's car, Gunnar Cortes of Mastic, suffered serious injuries.
