Flanders man indicted for bat attack

A 22 year old Flanders man arrested by State Police in Riverside last October for hitting a man with a baseball bat will be arraigned on a grand jury indictment in Riverhead on Monday (March 26, 2012).

Isidro DeLeon Galindo approached the 29-year-old victim at a gas station near the Highway 24 traffic circle in Flanders and struck him in the face. State Police said the attack was the culmination of a lengthy disagreement between the pair.

The victim suffered cuts and facial swelling and was treated for his injuries at Peconic Bay Medical Center.

State police charged Galindo with assault in the second degree and criminal possession of a weapon in the fourth degree.

A grand jury indicted Galindo March 12.
