**Trial of man charged with estranged wife's boyfriend's murder
concludes tomorrow**

Closing statements are scheduled for 10:00 am tomorrow (Wednesday, March 12, 2014) in criminal court in Riverhead in the homicide trial of Quinton Rubin, 36, charged with shooting his estranged wife's boyfriend to death last year, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Rubin, of Brentwood, entered a trailer on Kenneth Lane in Bay Shore and allegedly shot Sean Berry around 4:30 a.m. on November 13.

The trial, before State Supreme Court Justice William Condon, began March 3.
