## **Former Southold court clerk to be sentenced tomorrow**

The former Southold Senior Justice Court Clerk arrested last year for stealing \$231,000 in fines and bail money from the town court will be remanded to the Suffolk County jail tomorrow, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Christine Stulsky, 65, of New Suffolk, will be sentenced tomorrow (Wednesday, March 11) by State Supreme Court Justice John Collins (third floor of the courthouse) to a six month jail term and five years' probation with drug and psychiatric conditions.

Stulsky is required to pay the stolen money back and made a \$50,000 payment in January.

Her thefts of court funds began in January of 2009.

Stulsky was responsible for the collection and deposit of fines and bail funds, and reconciling court bank accounts.
