## **Oral argument Friday in Brooklyn as court considers convicted murderer Daniel Pelosi's appeal**

The state appellate courthouse on Monroe Place in Brooklyn will be the scene of oral arguments tomorrow (Friday, 3-13) as judges consider the appeal of Daniel Pelosi, the Center Moriches man convicted in 2004 of murdering investment banker Ted Ammon in 2001 in the victim's East Hampton mansion in October 2001, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Pelosi was arrested for Ammon's murder on March 24, 2004 and his trial began October 13, 2004.

After deliberating for three days, the jury found Pelosi guilty of murder in the second degree on December 14, 2004.

Pelosi, 51, is incarcerated in the maximum security Great Meadow Correctional Facility. He will be eligible for parole in August of 2031.

**The appeal in People v. Daniel Pelosi will be heard in the Appellate Division, Second Department in Brooklyn. The clerk's call of the court calendar is at 9:15 am and it is expected the court will hear the Pelosi arguments at 10:00 AM. (Pelosi's appeal is the fourth case on Friday's appellate court calendar.)**

**Directions to the courthouse from Long Island:**

Take the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway South  
to Exit 28 (Cadman Plaza West/Brooklyn  
Bridge/EXIT ONLY).

Turn left at the first traffic light (Old Fulton  
Street) and proceed under the overpass,  
making the first available right turn onto  
Henry Street.

After 2 lights, turn left onto Clark Street.  
Make the first available right turn onto  
Monroe Place where the courthouse is at the  
end of the block on the right.

*There is limited parking available on the  
streets surrounding the courthouse.*
