## **Deliberations start in Bay Shore homicide case**

Jurors in the murder trial of Wesley Paul, the Bay Shore man arrested in 2010 for stabbing his wife to death, began deliberations this afternoon.

Monica Paul, 40, a resident of an apartment at 407 East Main St, was allegedly attacked in her shower by her estranged husband Wesley Paul, 41.

A deputy medical examiner testified that the victim was stabbed four times; the fatal wound inflicted on her neck severing her carotid artery and jugular vein.

During her violent struggle with the defendant, the victim bit him on the nose.

Deliberations resume tomorrow morning at 9:30 am. Judge William Condon is presiding at trial.
