**Re: Investigation of dumping of contaminated NYC  
demolition debris on Islip town parkland**

Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota will provide an update today on the investigation of the illegal dumping, in a Town of Islip Park, of contaminated construction debris from New York City.

"The testing of debris samples collected a week ago has confirmed the presence of a dangerous contaminant," said DA Spota.

Exhibits include aerial maps and photos of bulldozers re-grading the surface soil to hide illegally dumped demolition debris.

Prosecutors and detectives assigned to the SCDA Government Corruption and the SCDA Environmental Unit are leading the probe which began on April 8.
