## **Parolee indicted for Parkway assault and robbery**

A Bay Shore man arrested by the US Marshal's Regional Fugitive Task Force three days after a violent assault and robbery of a woman on the shoulder of the Southern State Parkway will be arraigned on an indictment tomorrow (5/12/2015), Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

New York State Police Troopers responded to the scene at Exit 37 of the Southern State Parkway in the Town of Babylon on April 27 when a passing motorist observed an injured female and called 911. Police said Antoine Smiley, 38, fled the scene, leaving his car behind, after the assault and robbery.

On April 30, Smiley was apprehended by the Marshal's Fugitive Task Force without incident.

The defendant was on parole for an attempted assault conviction.

State Supreme Court Justice William Condon will unseal the indictment Tuesday in the criminal courthouse in Riverside. The court calendar is called at 9:30 am.
