## **Commercial burglary suspect indicted**

A 50 year old Huntington Station man suspected of committing 16 burglaries of restaurants, delis and pizza parlors in South Huntington, Huntington, Melville, Huntington Station, Elwood, Deer Park, East Farmingdale, North Lindenhurst, Hauppauge and Bay Shore will be arraigned on an indictment in Riverhead tomorrow, Thursday October 16, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Anthony Myles, the 6' 5, 300lb. defendant also known as "Tree Top", will be arraigned before Judge John Collins.
