**Bus driver charged with Aggravated DWI to be arraigned tomorrow**

A 48 year old school bus driver, arrested for aggravated DWI for driving with a blood alcohol level of .23, is scheduled to be arraigned on a grand jury indictment tomorrow (Thursday Nov. 1) in Riverhead, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota announced today.

On October 10, thirty minutes after the last child was dropped off the minibus, Robert Stundis of Bohemia was pulled over at Exit 60 on the LIE, in response to 911 calls about an erratic motorist driving with a flat tire.

According to the sheriff's deputy who made the stop, Stundis did not realize he had been driving on only 3 tires.

A half empty bottle of vodka was found in the console of the bus.

Suffolk County Judge James F.X. Doyle (second floor of the courthouse) will unseal the indictment. The calendar call is scheduled for 9:30 am.
