PRESS ADVISORY FOR TODAY, WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2013

Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota will announce this morning, Wednesday (October 2), at a press conference in his Hauppauge office, the results of a just concluded criminal investigation of an East Moriches man charged with the rape and sodomy of a woman in a Stony Brook home on November 20 last year.

Since December 1, Patrick O'Sullivan, 21, has been in the county jail in lieu of \$100,000 cash bail or one million dollars bond, charged with multiple counts of predatory sexual assault, rape in the first degree, criminal sexual act in the first degree, sexual abuse in the first degree, burglary in the first degree, and criminal use of a firearm, an armed felony.

"Our investigation has uncovered clear evidence of the defendant's planning of a new scheme he believed would result in his freedom," DA Spota said.

"Today he will learn that, upon conviction, he will be in prison for decades."
